Board of Directors Convene after Membership Meeting

Dear Buffalo Hill Golf Club Members,

As promised, the KGA Board of Directors met on November 3, 2008, to discuss member suggestions and input from the October 29 Special Meeting of the Membership.

After reviewing the written and verbal comments and suggestions at the meeting, the overwhelming request was to reconsider the junior membership fees for both the Cameron 9 and Championship 18. Accordingly, the Board took the member's suggestion and agreed to continue unrestricted access for juniors on both courses. Therefore, the junior rate for 2009 will be \$175 (compared to the previously proposed rate for both courses of \$250). The Board also was asked by the membership to consider allocating a portion of the junior and student rates to the capital fund, hence, the Board agreed to allocate \$25 of the junior and student memberships to the capital fund.

The membership also asked the Board to consider lowering the 2009 non-member peak green fee rate of \$65, which was an increase of \$15 per round over the 2008 rate of \$50. Members stated that many of them bring their friends, guests, and relatives from out of town, and that a lower green fee rate should be considered. The Board agreed with the suggestion, lowering the peak season rate to \$58, with \$5 of that fee going to the capital fund.

In addition, the Board discussed a lower rate for families, however, after considering the advice from a prominent Buffalo Hill member who attended the Special Meeting, the Board decided to take the member's advice and not adopt a family rate.

Finally, a fund to help members who are financially hard-shipped by the capital fee is under consideration. Details of the program are not yet worked out, but Mark Agather, a long-time Buffalo Hill member, along with other Buffalo Hill members are determined to establish a fund that encourages **"members helping members!"**

The Board of Directors would like to express it's sincere thanks and gratitude to the 100 members who attended the Special Meeting, and the numerous members who wrote e-mails and letters expressing their opinions and offering their suggestions. A sincere thank you to all Buffalo Hill members for your continued support. **The capital budget fee has just one purpose; it is an investment in our future to ensure that we may all continue to enjoy this great golf course for many years to come!** Let's continue to unite together and keep our **"BEST GOLF COURSE IN THE FLATHEAD VALLEY"** reign going (we're going for six straight years in 2009!).

Remember, your Buffalo Hill membership entitles you to play **TWO GOLF COURSES;** the Cameron 9 AND the Championship 18 for the price of just ONE! ***Adult Membership \$674 - EARLY BIRD PRICE!** For the avid player that plays golf on a regular basis, but who does NOT need MSGA handicap service or range pass. **The Adult Member price of \$674** includes \$125 for KGA'S Capital Budget (for use only on capital projects, not for operation expenses) and entitled to unlimited play on both the Cameron 9 and the Championship 18 course.

Adult Cameron 9 Membership \$499 *NEW for 2009!

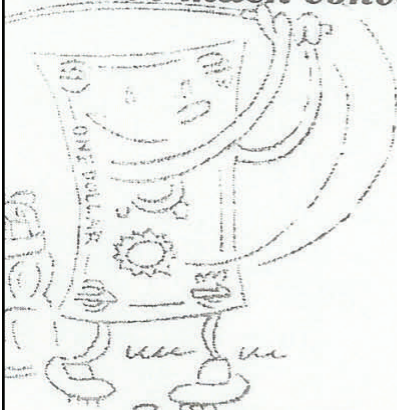
